## Rules, Regulations and FAQs

### play format...

Each team must consist of 4-6 players with a minimum of two boys and two girls

10 and Under teams use 60' courts with orange balls;  
12 and Under teams use 78' courts with green balls

Round Robin matches consist of six timed sets;  
Set time based on total number of teams in the event

**Sets played:** Boys and Girls Doubles,  
Boys and Girls Singles, Mixed Doubles (2)

### ...scoring and coaching format

Total games won in each set counts toward score;  
The team with most total points after six sets wins

Coaching is allowed at any time as long as it does not interrupt play;  
Only the designated team coach is allowed to coach

No Ad Scoring;  
Players may sub upon completion of a point for any reason

Cheering is encouraged! All players should be on an assigned court, either playing or cheering for their teammates.
